

CC installs electronic billboard

The board members and staff of the Lac du Bonnet Community Centre are pleased to announce that the electronic billboard they raised funds for has now been installed and is ready for public use.

Facility administrator Kim Buhay said the highly visible sign, at a cost of over \$39,400, came complete with sophisticated software and technology that allows her to prepare ad copy right on her desktop and send it directly to the unit with relative ease. She is currently acquainting herself with the various functions and believes it will take no time to master the program.

"The project has become a reality after two years in the making" said Buhay. "The centre organized numerous volunteers who worked four bingo sessions. The community has been so supportive and we are grateful for their generous contributions towards the

sign. We received donations from local businesses and organizations totaling \$14,000."

"It was definitely a process and took some time to get it all together, but community groups and businesses really came through," said Sharlyn Reitlo, LdBCC board VP.

Non-profit organizations will receive a special discount to use the sign, and groups who made donations to purchase the sign will be able to post messages at half price.

Crop residue burning authorization begins

Manitoba Agriculture, Food and Rural Development (MAFRD) reminds producers who choose to burn crop residue that authorization is required between Aug. 1 and Nov. 15.

Authorizations are issued daily by 11 a.m. based on weather, moisture and favourable smoke dispersion conditions. Night burning is banned year round.

Manitoba's controlled burning program is part of the Burning of Crop Residue and Non-crop Herbage Regulation. The program was introduced to protect public health and safety while allowing farmers to deal with difficult straw management problems.

Straw burning regulations are

enforced by environment officers and the RCMP. Failure to follow the regulations could result in fines of up to \$50,000.

Many producers use alternative methods of dealing with crop residue such as chopping and spreading the straw or leaving straw they have for sale on the Manitoba Hay Listing Service. More information on these and other alternative methods of dealing with crop residue is available on MAFRD's website.
