The criteria and means of applying for this scholarship are set out below.

Applicants must:

- Be accepted by an accredited Canadian postsecondary institution.
- Be attending an accredited postsecondary institution on a fulltime basis.
- Be pursuing a program that correlates to their passion(s).
- Be able to communicate and provide observable evidence of their passion(s)
- Email a “Letter of Intent” to Foundation at info@lacdubonnetfoundation.ca by May 31st.

Letter of Intent

All applicants wishing to apply for this scholarship will provide a Letter of Intent to the Foundation’s Grants committee. The Letter of Intent must include the following:

- Name and email address of the applicant
- Name and address of the Post-secondary Institution where they are enrolled including name of faculty & student ID #
- Chosen Field of Study
- Expected Length of Program and current status in program
- A description (100 words or less) explaining why you are the most deserving candidate for the Brittany Bung Memorial Scholarship, including Information on any financial need
- Two reference letters are required focusing on their knowledge of the applicant’s passion - a school reference and a personal reference vouching for their dedication as a student and good person. Reference letters must be submitted in PDF format
