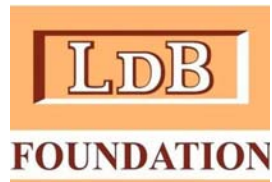
### **Applicants must:**

- Be accepted by an accredited postsecondary institution.
- Be attending an accredited postsecondary institution for both the fall and winter sessions.
- Be pursuing a program that correlates to their passion, talent, and intellect.
- Email a “Letter of Intent” to the CRMS Board at [grant@lacdubonnetfoundation.ca](mailto:grant@lacdubonnetfoundation.ca) by May 31st.
- Be able to communicate and provide observable evidence of their passion, talent, intellect, achievement, and determination in a presentation to the CRMS Board.

### **Letter of Intent**

All applicants will provide a Letter of Intent to the CRMS committee. The Letter of Intent must include the following:

- Name and email address
- Post-secondary Institution
- Chosen Field
- Expected Length of Program
- A conclusion (100 words or less) explaining why you are the most deserving candidate for the CRM Scholarship
- Three reference letters are required focusing on their knowledge of the applicant’s passion.



### **Presentation**

All candidates will present themselves to the CRMS committee. The focus of the presentation will be to display, highlight, and provide observable evidence of the candidate's passion, talent, intellect, achievement, and determination. A SMART board, speaker system, podium, white board, and large presentation area will be at the presenter's disposal. There is no set time limit for the presentation. Other arrangements to assist in the presentation of materials can be made by contacting Ms. Reynolds before the scheduled meeting date.

Candidates should be prepared to answer questions from the committee in response to their presentation.
